



Dance Class Uniform Attire

Every June, our students are invited to perform in an informal Open House Concert for family and friends. In lieu of expensive costumes, all participants wear their class uniform. The correct attire for the Open House Concert can be used as a guide when buying dancewear for class. Students are encouraged to wear their uniform in class, but may wear other similarly appropriate dancewear. If you have any questions about appropriate dancewear, consult your instructor.

Although dancewear requirements vary by class, a few general rules do apply. No costumes, tutus, jeans, boxer shorts or other baggy clothing are permitted. They compromise the safety of the dancer and prevent the instructor from seeing the line of the body and giving adequate correction. Failure to wear appropriate dancewear to class could result in students being asked to sit out the class. In cold weather a solid color dance sweater or fitted tee-shirt may be worn for warmth.

Hair Styles for Dance Students

For all dancers, hair should be pulled back away from the face. Long hair needs to be secured neatly in a bun and net or with a barrette. Short hair should be kept off the face with a headband or barrettes. Jewelry such as watches, bracelets, dangling earrings and rings should be left at home and not worn in class. Flying hair or jewelry can cause injury and interferes with class work. Staff will assist as needed.

Pre-Dance & Ballet

Class Uniform for Pre-Dance, Ballet 1 and Ballet 2

Girls: black tank leotard (sleeveless) without ornamentation, light pink tights and pink ballet slippers. Boys: black tank leotard, black boys tights, black or white ballet slippers

Class Uniform for Ballet 3

Girls: Mirella 207 seafoam green, light pink tights and pink ballet slippers.

Boys: black tank or capsleeve leotard, black boys tights, black or white ballet slippers

Class Uniform for Ballet 4 and 5

Girls: Mirella 207 royal blue, light pink tights and pink ballet slippers.

Boys: black tank or cap-sleeve leotard, black boys tights, black or white ballet slippers

Adult Ballet

Adult classes have no specific class uniform, however standard solid color leotards, tights and ballet slippers are recommended. Bulky or lumpy warm-up gear such as sweat-suits will interfere with movement and body line..

Tap

Class Uniform for Tap 1 and 2

Girls: black tank leotard (sleeveless) without ornamentation, black tights and black tap shoes. Boys: white short-sleeved shirt, black tights and black tap shoes

Adult Tap

Adult classes have no specific class uniform, however a fitted solid color T-shirt, pants that allow comfortable movement such as jazz pants or yoga pants and tap shoes are recommended. Bulky or lumpy warm-up gear such as sweat-suits will interfere with movement and body line.

Jazz

Class Uniform for Jazz 1 and 2:

Girls and boys: black tank leotard (sleeveless) without ornamentation, black jazz pants, yoga pants or black tights, black jazz shoes or black ballet slippers.

Modern

Class Uniform for Modern 1:

Girls and boys: black tank leotard (sleeveless) without ornamentation, black jazz/yoga pants or black stirrup or footless tights with bare feet.

Adult Modern

Adult classes have no specific class uniform, however a fitted solid color leotard, pants that allow comfortable movement such as jazz pants or yoga pants and bare feet are recommended. Bulky or lumpy warm-up gear such as sweat-suits will interfere with movement and body line.
