Children's Dancing Roles

1:00 Registration

1:30 Audition

Dancers must be at least six years old, at least in the first grade and have a minimum of one year's dance experience. PMA levels I and II, should audition with this group. Parts drawn from this level will be Cards, Pawns, Caterpillar and supporting character roles. No individually prepared material will be required.

Intermediate & Advanced Dancers

1:45 Registration

2:15 Audition

We will be casting for intermediate to advanced corps and principal parts. No individually prepared material will be required. PMA levels 3, 4, 5 and Open Adult should audition with this group. Women capable of advanced work en pointe, will be asked to remain for an extended audition. All principal parts will be double cast. Parts being cast at this audition: Flowers, Lead Weed, Royal Cards, Royal Chess,

Insects, Alice, Cheshire Cat, White Rabbit, Humpty-Dumpty, March Hare

Actors and Supernumeraries

No audition is required, however those interested should contact us by phone or email. Parts drawn from this level will be supporting character and walk-on roles. In addition to teens and adults, we also have a limited number of supernumerary parts for children ages 4-6.
