

Auditions are open to anyone who meets the criteria below, regardless of where they receive their training. We will be casting for supporting acting characters as well as adult, children's, intermediate and advanced dancing roles

**Children's Roles
1:30 Registration-2:00 Audition**

Performers must be at least six years old and have a minimum of one year of dance experience. PMA levels I and II should audition with this group. Parts drawn from this level will be villagers.

Intermediate & Advanced Dancers

2:30 Registration-3:00 Audition

We will be casting for principal dancers and intermediate to advanced corps parts. Women capable of advanced work en pointe must bring their pointe shoes. Men should have some performance experience. No individually prepared material will be required. PMA levels III and up should audition with this group.
